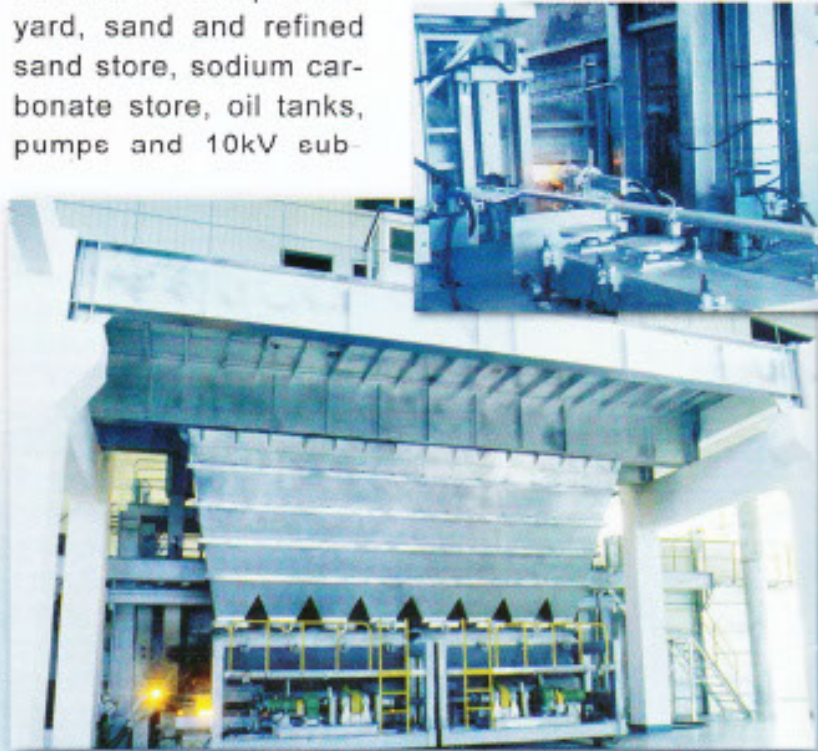

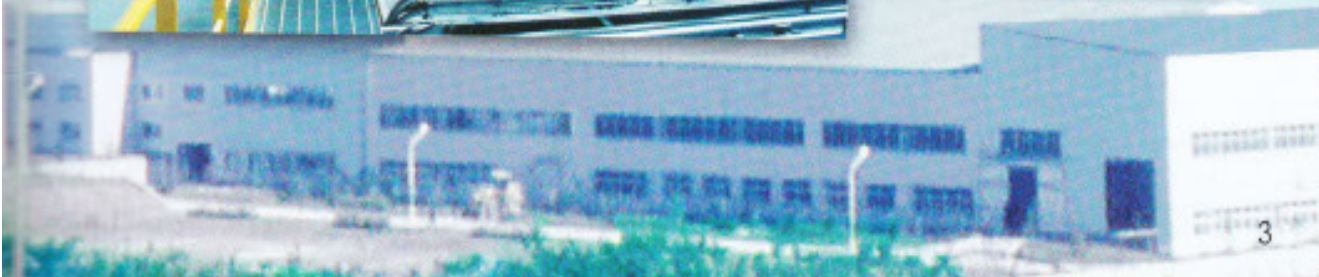

The moulding shop is equipped with tin melting furnace and gripping rollers for moulding flat glass and the cooling shop is



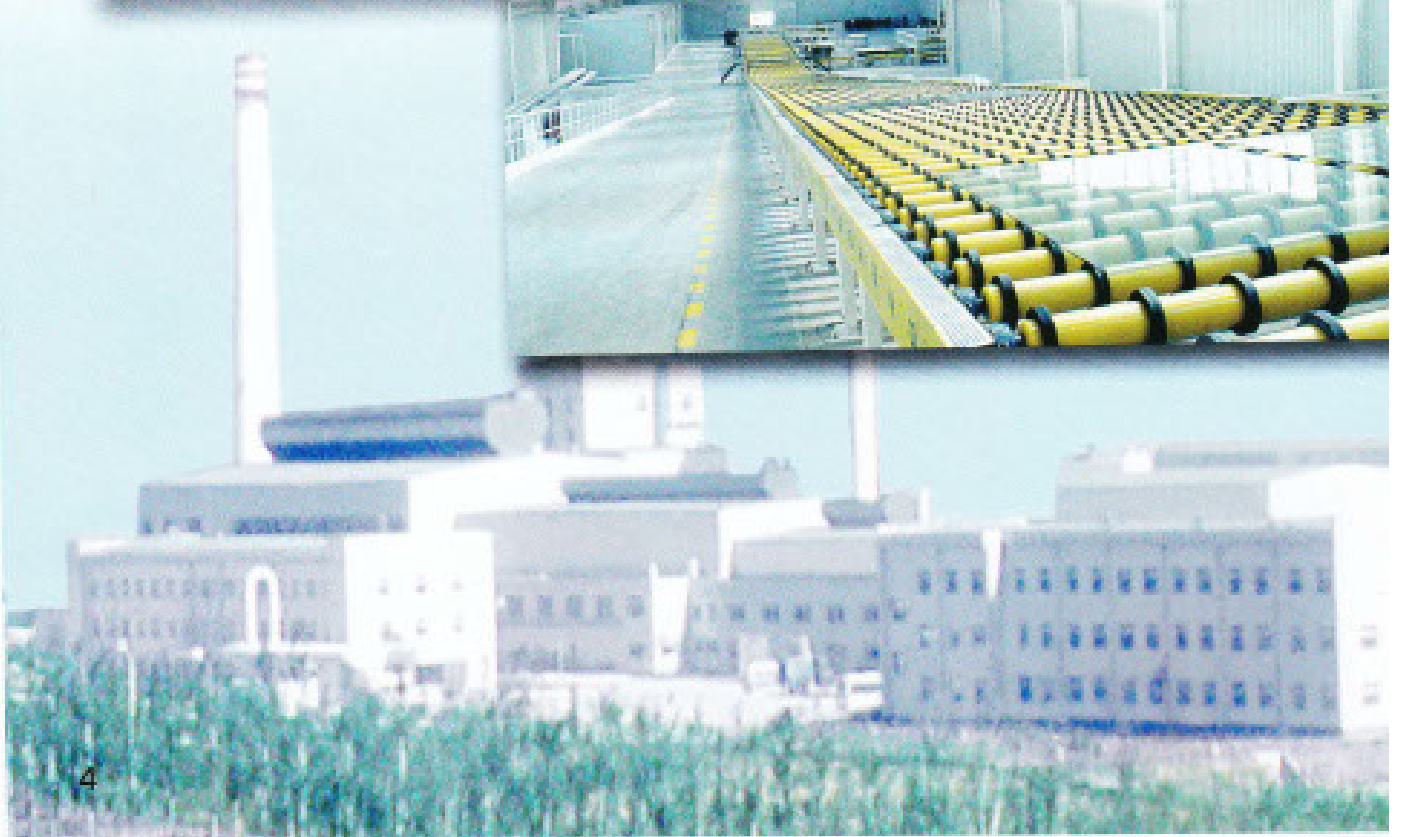
furnished with large-size blowers and cutting facilities so as to turn out any size of glass.

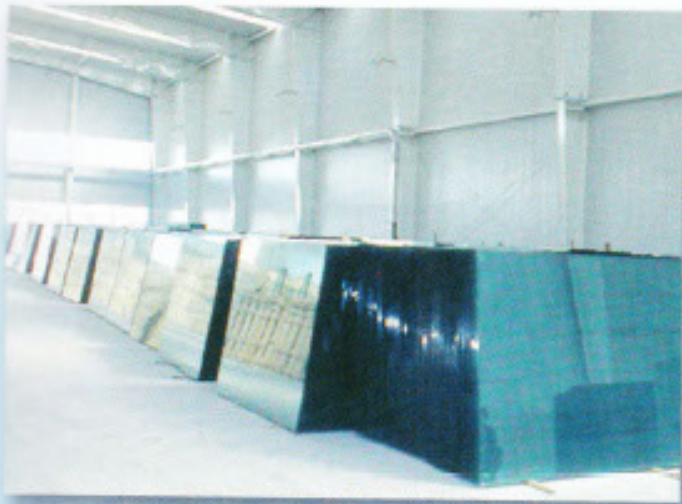
All the production processes of the factory from feeding of raw materials to packing are on a stream line. Its daily output is tens of thousands of square metres.



The size of flat glass is 2,000x1,500mm, 3,050x2,134mm and 4,000x3,000mm and the thickness is 3 to 12mm.

At present, high-quality flat glass is being mass-produced at the factory fed with silica sand, feldspar, dolomite, marble and other raw materials abundant in our country.

The Pyongyang Bicycle Joint Venture Factory set up as a joint venture enterprise between the DPRK Committee for Promotion of External Economic Cooperation and the Chinese Tianjin Digital Trade Co., Ltd. is a promising producer of various kinds of bicycles.

The factory with an annual capacity of some hundred thousand bicycles is equipped with streamlined production processes.



"Moranbong"-brand bicycles come in tens of kinds for the purpose of racing, mountaineering and travelling. They also include bicycles designed for children and the handicapped together with different kinds of trolleys.



The mountain bike models S-02, S-03, S-04 and S-05 consist of main frames and front forks fitted with tiptop buffers. Their change gear has 12, 18 and 21 teeth and tyre size is mainly 26 inches.

Electric motor cycle comprises models D-01 and D-02. Their main frames and buffered front forks made of aluminum alloy are argon-welded. Their speed is 20km an hour and the output is 200W.

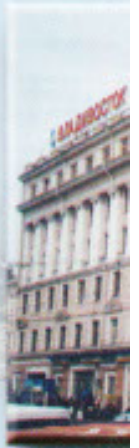

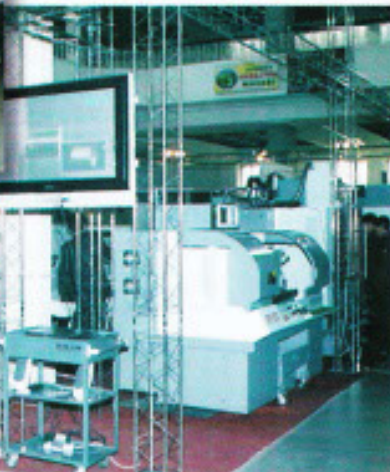
