Comrade graduates of the revolutionary schools  
who are visiting their dear “childhood homes” on this  
significant anniversary of their founding,

All officials and members of the staff of the  
revolutionary schools,

Dear comrades,

I offer you my congratulations as you celebrate the  
75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Mangyongdae  
Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok  
Revolutionary School amid the blessings of our Party  
and all the people across the country.

I also offer hearty congratulations and  
encouragement to all the graduates of the schools who,  
deeply mindful of the firm resolve they made during  
their days at the schools, are now making devoted  
efforts for the Party and the people at the posts of  
national defence and in various fields of socialist  
construction.

Availing myself of this opportunity, I pay noble  
tribute to the revolutionary martyrs who dedicated their  
precious lives to the Party, the country, the happiness of

the people and our bright future, and I extend my sincere feelings to their bereaved families who are invariably devoting their pure conscience as they follow the road of loyalty and patriotism the martyrs could not follow to the end.

Students of the revolutionary schools,

Comrade graduates of the revolutionary schools,

I can scarcely suppress my joy at being among all these faces I have always longed so much to see, here at this significant gathering at the campus of the revolutionary school in historic Mangyongdae.

The 75-year history of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School is a period in which our Party has remained infinitely loyal to its moral obligation to the revolutionary forerunners and, staking its fate on the inheritance of the revolutionary cause, has acted with utmost sincerity in training reserve revolutionaries.

The development of the revolutionary schools began on October 12, 1947, when they were inaugurated at a ceremony held in the presence of the great leader Comrade Kim Il Sung. In fact, it can be said that the course of their development has mirrored the history of our Republic and of our regular revolutionary armed forces.

Our Juche revolution established the schools for training its pillars even before founding the state and the army. Then it identified the indomitable revolutionaries they produced as its backbone and raised them to lead the development of the state and the army.

Ever since they were established by the leader, our revolutionary schools have, by developing into “pedigree farms” for training able revolutionaries under the care of the Party, made a huge contribution to the cause of following the sacred, protracted road of steadfastly carrying on, from one generation to the next, the lineage of the Juche revolution that was launched on Mt Paektu.

They have brought up a large number of loyal patriots who have given, and are giving, strong impetus to the growth of our state and army while dedicating their all to the revolution and the people, trusting their leader alone even when times are bad. They have formed an impregnable wall around the Party. This is an imperishable exploit performed by our revolutionary schools.

It is a source of great pride for our Party and people that they have such great revolutionary homes which add eternal youthful vigour to the cause of Juche as it progresses on the strength of the faith and indomitable

spirit of true revolutionaries and which constitute key assets for our state's lasting prosperity.

To train the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs as indomitable revolutionaries who will be at the heart of the hardcore of the revolutionary ranks and lead the advance and development in any field or at any post they are assigned to—this is the idea consistently and invariably maintained by our Party in educating the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs.

It is because the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs, together with and in the lead of all the other people throughout the country, have supported the leadership of the Party faithfully and single-heartedly that our cause has been able to win victory after victory while keeping its red colour, even in the face of the historical upheavals.

The first-generation graduates who, wearing the uniform symbolic of the blood of the anti-Japanese forerunners, had attended the inaugural ceremony of the revolutionary school and heard Comrade Kim Il Sung's speech, contributed their own blood to safeguarding the Supreme Headquarters and winning the great victory in the fierce Fatherland Liberation War. It was they, too, who admirably played a pivotal and hardcore role at important positions of the Party

and the state and at other revolutionary posts during the years of socialist construction.

All the achievements recorded by the graduates of the revolutionary schools at the cost of their sincere efforts and their sweat and blood have, without exception, served as the solid cornerstone and fertile soil for our state to progress and our people to prosper.

Numerous graduates of the revolutionary schools have, with utter loyalty to the Party, dedicated their all unsparingly for the sake of the victory of the revolutionary cause of Juche. Typical of them are comrades Yon Hyong Muk, Pak Song Bong, Sim Chang Wan and Kim Yong Chun.

Comrade Hyon Chol Hae was also a graduate of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School.

Among the graduates of the Mangyongdae Revolutionary School, three became head of government of our Republic, three marshals of the Korean People's Army, and scores Heroes, including triple and double ones. This is eloquent testimony to the great trust the Party and the leaders have put in the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs and the tremendous efforts they have made to train them as pillars of our state.

Our Party, which regards ideology and spirit as a

revolutionary's greatest asset, leads the revolution in such a way that the intentions and feats of parents are exalted through the life and struggle of their children. Thanks to this style of inheritance, which is unique to the Workers' Party of Korea, the Juche revolution is achieving victory after victory from one generation to the next.

Our Party's firm determination is to inherit for all eternity the lineage of Mangyongdae by dint of its correct idea of training a reserve of revolutionaries and of its leadership. Thanks to the responsible efforts it is making to this end, Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School will remain eternally faithful to their revolutionary character and mission as the essential artery of inheritance and schools of the WPK.

Comrades,

Our revolution has recorded victory alone from one century to the next and generation after generation. Yet there are still many mountainous obstacles to scale on the road ahead.

Our revolution is following an uncharted course. But we must surely accomplish it. Since we must hew out the way ahead by our own efforts, the difficulties and challenges we are facing are inevitably enormous.



We have achieved remarkable successes in the new century of the Juche era, and these have raised the position and national power of our state to an unprecedented level. We have also accumulated invaluable experience in the course of overcoming successive national trials and of pushing strenuously ahead with socialist construction on the strength of our unbending willpower, of our revolutionary unity, and of our extraordinary fighting efficiency.

We are surely capable of winning victory by our own efforts. However severe the hardships and whatever crisis we may face in the future, we should staunchly maintain our self-respect and self-confidence and faithfully implement our unique development strategy. By doing so, we can ensure that socialism advances without interruption.

If we are to achieve the greatest national glory through a courageous and adroit struggle even in the worst circumstances, we need, first and foremost, to have able commanding personnel and a dependable hardcore force capable of turning every front and post into an impregnable revolutionary position and of performing their tasks flawlessly.

It can be said that the present development of our Party, state and army, and their future, depend on how

the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs who have passed or are passing through the stage of their growth into pillars of the Juche revolution at the revolutionary schools, work and prepare themselves.

This is why our Party, which attaches special significance to the celebration of the 75<sup>th</sup> founding anniversary of the revolutionary schools, has arranged a grand gathering of their students and graduates here at Mangyongdae today, so as to remind them once again of the demands and expectations of the country and the people.

If the sons and daughters of our revolutionary martyrs brace themselves to lead the struggle for making incessant innovations and a steady advance at their posts and units, and thus contribute to attaining the high goals for achieving the comprehensive development of socialist construction and rouse the masses by their noble example, we can take a big stride forward in overcoming today's trials and advancing the revolution.

With the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School as a turning point, we should bring about a major advance in the education and edification of the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs.

This is a requirement of the revolution, and the high expectations our Party and people currently place in the revolutionary schools.

Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School are “pedigree farms” for bringing up outstanding talents who will contribute to carrying out the sacred cause of making the main pillars and roots of the Juche revolution eternally strong and turning the entire revolutionary ranks into an elite force by dint of their great spiritual strength.

To cultivate a hardcore reserve who will dependably carry forward the lineage of the Juche revolution and pillars who will be the key support in implementing the revolutionary cause of Juche is the fundamental task facing Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School.

Only when these revolutionary schools train their students to have the greatest spiritual strength by inheriting the fighting spirit and indomitable soul of their forerunners and making them part of their ideological and mental qualities, will the red flag of revolution never fade and our revolutionary position be fortified as a pure integral whole which is invulnerable to all heterogeneous ideas.

The schools' general work should be oriented to preparing the sons and daughters of our revolutionary martyrs as reliable successors who dependably carry forward the baton of the Juche revolution, and hardcore elements who are committed to the ideas of our Party alone.

As I have always stressed, a revolutionary character is not inherited of its own accord.

Sons and daughters do not grow up to be revolutionaries simply because their fathers are revolutionaries. This has been shown in the history of the world revolutionary movement as well as that of our country.

Every element of a revolutionary's ideological and mental qualities, ranging from loyalty and obligation to the leader to a true heart for the people, unshakeable faith, unyielding fortitude and genuine humanity, is cultivated solely through revolutionary education and studies, constant self-cultivation, and practice.

The revolutionary schools should give top priority to, and focus on, politico-ideological education.

The lineage of the revolution championed by our Party is essentially our ideological bloodline; to train the students of the revolutionary schools as a reserve hardcore who will resolutely carry forward the

traditions of their forerunners' ideology, faith and loyalty—this remains, today and tomorrow just as it did yesterday, always essential to the education of the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs.

The sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs should be exceptional not in their origin, academic career and official post, but in their loyalty to the Party and in their revolutionary spirit. They should live honourably before the collective and society by devoting themselves to the people and performing outstanding feats in the struggle.

Ideological education should focus on making boundless loyalty to the Party the foremost “family” and school tradition of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School, the childhood homes of the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs, and ensuring that the students' hearts beat for ever with the blood of faith which will never be contaminated.

Our revolution, as it was in the past, is today being defended and is advancing steadfastly on the strength of the invariable faith of absolutely trusting and following the Party.

Before imparting scientific and technical knowledge to the students of the revolutionary schools, we should

inculcate in their minds as a firm faith a pure sense of moral obligation which will remain unchangeable in any adversity, as well as a resolute determination and will to live up to the Party's trust.

We should continue to direct a major effort to implanting in their hearts the revolutionary spirit of our forerunners, the soul of revolutionaries.

Only those vanguard fighters who embody the revolutionary spirit of resisting the enemy to the death as the inherent creed of their struggle, not simply chanting it in speeches or songs, and those who are exemplary in all aspects including that of political awareness with which to accept and implement the ideas and policies of the Party and that of an attitude with which to support the policies of the state and do their full duty, deserve the honour of being called graduates of the revolutionary schools.

We should encourage the students to nourish themselves on the history of the struggle of the anti-Japanese revolutionary forerunners and the heroic generation who won the great victory in the war. We should also inculcate in them the ennobling spirit of the preceding generations who were boundlessly loyal to the Party and the revolution.

We need to tell them in detail about the spiritual

world of their fathers who glorified their lives as faithful people in the course of supporting the cause of the Party, as well as about what they thought and how loyal they were at every moment of their struggle and life.

Today, as I look at you, sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs, at the campus in Mangyongdae on this significant occasion, I am reminded again of the first-generation graduates of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School who were boundlessly loyal to the Party's cause.

Our Party demands that a great effort and proper guidance be directed to the spiritual development of the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs so that they can all inherit the noble spirit and revolutionary traits of the loyal people of the preceding generations.

The revolutionary schools should make it a major target to train all their students to be as loyal as the school's first-generation graduates, and should conduct education in loyalty and revolutionary traditions in a theoretical, substantial and intensive manner.

Revolution without patriotism is unthinkable.

The aim of the revolution we are making in the face of all the trials is, in the final analysis, to achieve the prosperity of the country at the earliest possible date.

The revolutionary schools should educate their

students to be mindful of the fact that patriotism is synonymous with revolution so that they can always bear the flag of our Republic in mind and be firmly resolved to devote their all to the great dignity and eternal prosperity of the country.

The education the revolutionary schools conduct for enhancing the class consciousness of their students should be assiduous, substantial and ceaseless. In this way they can ensure that their students are always aware of their class origin and filled with a resolve to become fierce fighters safeguarding our class position, which was defended at the cost of the blood of their forerunners.

The revolutionary schools should further intensify education in collectivism so as to ensure that all their students, regarding the slogan “One for all and all for one!” as the standard and iron principle of their struggle and life, give full play to the communist traits of putting the interests of the collective before their own in everything they do, and of devoting themselves willingly for the good of their comrades.

They should pay close attention to preparing the students to be genuine persons who are steeped in noble moral ethics.

As their students are living away from their relatives



at an early age, the revolutionary schools should, on behalf of their parents, teach them the etiquette of daily life, down to the last details, as well as the norms of social and public behaviour.

They should be models for every other school across the country in terms of the education and edification they provide, and also leading schools which other educational units can learn from. In particular, they should make it their most important task to create a reserve of military specialists who will contribute to making our People's Army more sophisticated and high-tech.

Ten years have passed since universal 12-year compulsory education was enforced, pursuant to the policy of the Party and the state, yet general secondary education has still not attained a satisfactory level. The revolutionary schools should become a trailblazer and set an example in putting general secondary education on the track of assured rejuvenation and a leap forward.

Now that the educational conditions and environment at Mangyongdae Revolutionary School have been significantly upgraded, it should direct efforts to improving its teaching methods and the quality of its education.

It is important, if we are to work out our own unique

methodology for training talented people, to make proactive use of IT and intelligent educational equipment and to introduce the world's latest teaching experience and most advanced scientific and technological data.

This revolutionary school should develop prodigy training aimed at producing a larger number of students of outstanding talent and with practical skills, a reserve of military specialists who are fully capable of shouldering the future of our army.

Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School, too, should act positively to explore and apply innovative and effective educational methods according to its various levels of education. In particular, it should focus its efforts on bringing the teaching of economics-related subjects closer to the developing reality, with a view to training an excellent reserve of women cadres who can play a major role in state building.

It is important to step up military education among the students at Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School.

Military education at Mangyongdae Revolutionary School should be conducted in a proactive and dynamic manner, with the main emphasis on basic education for training the students as officers who are fully

conversant with the various arms and services.

Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School should further enhance the quality of its military education with a view to improving its students' ability to command and manage sub-units. It should make exacting demands on them so that, through their day-to-day life, they can gain experience to this end.

Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School should work out practical artillery and other military education programmes and raise the intensity of military training so as to bring up their students as competent reserve officers who can contribute substantially to consolidating our revolutionary armed forces.

The students of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School are given horse-riding lessons in addition to live-firing drills and swimming lessons. An important purpose of this is to bring them up as genuine combatants.

If they master horsemanship, marksmanship and an ability to swim during their school days, it will be a great help to them in preparing themselves as versatile combatants and field commanding officers who can execute their combat tasks satisfactorily while handling all possible warfare situations on their own initiative.

Mangyongdae Revolutionary School should make

more effective use of simulators.

It should work effectively to organize and guide student visits to front-line areas and their participation in military service in KPA sub-units so that these times can serve as opportunities for them to achieve a good understanding of the reality in combat units and gain valuable experience of military service.

Training students in the vibrant reality is an important method of education.

It is important to temper them in the thick of the reality so that they are trained as steel-strong, genuine revolutionary talents, rather than bring them up to be self-indulgent children.

Recently we have mobilized the students of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School for the housing construction project in the Taephyong area. The aim is to help them to understand the justness of Party policy, foster a patriotic spirit, develop a strong will and spirit to overcome difficulties, and learn how to work in the reality. In this way they can prepare themselves as pillars who will shoulder the future of the country.

The revolutionary schools should avail themselves of various occasions, such as military parades, military training, grand socialist construction and working in support of rural communities, with a view to

purposefully organizing and resolutely undertaking the work for instilling in them an iron will and spiritual strength with which to advance without hesitation in the face of ordeals and difficulties.

In addition, visits to the revolutionary battle sites in the Mt Paektu area, rather than reading books, should be an opportunity for them to cherish in their hearts the indomitable fighting spirit of the anti-Japanese guerrillas through firsthand experience, while marching across virgin snow with their leggings on, building a campfire and cooking their own rice.

Due attention should be paid to education and edification designed to nurture the students as well-rounded revolutionary talents.

A good ability to write and make presentations is an essential qualification of a leading figure in the revolution.

The revolutionary schools should encourage their students to develop the habit of writing a diary and should organize regular meetings, such as book sessions and presentations of their compositions, so that they develop the ability to express their thoughts fully both in writing and in speeches from their childhood.

They should direct great efforts to ensuring that their

students acquire rich cultural and emotional attainments with which they can move the hearts of the masses and enliven the atmosphere of the collective by singing, dancing and playing sports with them.

Students of the revolutionary schools,

Our Party and people have huge and great expectations for each of you.

I am never more pleased than when I see the dignified appearance of you who are growing vigorously while loudly singing your school songs. In your bright eyes, I see the rosy future of our state and the admirable images of you, who will play an active role as pillars of the Party and the revolution.

You should always be aware that, when the Party assigns you to important posts in the future, you will be unable to remain at them if you are poorly prepared. You should make positive efforts to prepare yourselves as military and political activists who can make a major contribution to the Party and the people with both literary and military accomplishments.

You should not idle away a single school day, but should study hard and take part in an organizational life purposefully and in good faith so as to develop the revolutionary spirit and sense of organization and discipline.

I am well aware that the teachers at Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School make devoted efforts, unknown to others, in looking after the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs like their real parents and relatives would, by taking upon themselves the most difficult tasks in education and edification.

Comrade teachers at the revolutionary schools,

In the new era, a radical improvement in education is essentially that in teachers' qualifications.

Your responsibility and role in training the students at the revolutionary schools into the genuine successors and a reserve hardcore who will take up the baton of the Juche revolution, are vital.

You should have a deep sense of responsibility that the work you are shouldering will serve the lasting prosperity of our Party and country, which is an important element of the revolution, and with this always foremost in your mind you should devote all your inexhaustible passion, fighting spirit and clear conscience to the education and edification of your students.

Without relaxing even for a moment your consciousness that you are working at the revolutionary schools to which the Party attaches so

much importance, you should make proactive efforts for your revolutionary training and enhancement of your qualifications by setting yourselves high goals and maintaining your personal discipline.

The teachers at the revolutionary schools are training devoted revolutionaries and “intrepid tigers,” and they should have a greater revolutionary spirit, make patriotic fervour part of their mental qualities, be perfect in terms of their human features, and possess the highest level of qualifications and capabilities as educators.

You should care for your students with parental affection.

You should pour kindred affection on your students by taking care of them like devoted yet strict parents and brothers and sisters who lead them with complete sincerity, so that they grow into human beings who are perfect in every aspect.

You should, with the attitude of parents who are strictly bringing up their beloved children, be scrupulous in admonishing and criticizing your students who commit faults so that they correct them promptly. You should make increasingly exacting demands on them so that they fully observe the established order and rules. In this way they can



acquire in their childhood the habit of doing only what the Party tells them to do.

In order to effect a decisive turn in all the work at the revolutionary schools, it is necessary, first and foremost, to bring about innovations in the working attitude and style of their Party organizations and leading officials.

The Party organizations at the schools should focus political work on thoroughly establishing the Party's unified command system at the schools and training all the students to be powerful revolutionary talents.

They should step up Party guidance with the aim of further stoking the flames of the Three-Revolution Red Flag Movement and ensuring that the youth league and children's union organizations briskly conduct the movements to win the title of Honoured Red Flag Class and the July 15 Honour Student Prize.

They should establish iron discipline at the schools and step up the struggle and edification so as to prevent the infiltration of even the slightest manifestation of those elements which the Party condemns the most and which are alien to it, the revolution and socialism.

There should never be the slightest room for a weed or noxious plant to take root in the revolutionary schools, which are flower gardens cultivated by our

Party with so much effort.

We need to further strengthen education and guidance for preparing educators to be truly career revolutionaries who are steadfast politically and ideologically and well-behaved, and who possess complete qualifications and abilities. We also need to pay close attention to providing all the teachers with good working and living conditions so that they can devote themselves to implementing Party policy on the education of the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs.

The leading officials at the revolutionary schools should work at all times as the Party expects and dedicate their all to the good of their students, deeply mindful of the heavy responsibility they bear for thoroughly applying the Party's ideas and policies on rearing the sons and daughters of the revolutionary martyrs and for ensuring that the Party's warm affection and care reach the students.

The commanding personnel of the KPA should apply themselves to the task, with the standpoint of being the masters of it, of strengthening Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School.

Strengthening the revolutionary schools can be

regarded as the first process in training cadres for the KPA.

These days, the Party is stressing the importance of building up the ranks of the KPA's military and political cadres. The commanding personnel of the KPA should display their sincerity to the full so as to ensure that substantial achievements are made in the work of the revolutionary schools, with the mindset that they are cultivating the "pedigree farms," sowing the seeds and applying the manure needed.

The General Political Bureau, the Ministry of National Defence and the General Staff should step up their political, policy-oriented and practical guidance over the educational work at the revolutionary schools, provide them with educational conditions and their students with living conditions in a responsible manner, and promptly solve any problems arising in the regular operation, maintenance and management of the educational facilities and equipment the Party went to so much trouble to provide and in the sprucing up of the educational environment.

They should adopt measures for the teachers at the revolutionary schools to learn from the good experience of other educational institutions, improve their qualifications as educators and broaden their

vision, and also establish a proper supply service system and foundations for this work at the schools.

I want to stress the need for Party organizations at all levels to pay close attention also to the work with the students and graduates at the revolutionary schools and with the bereaved families of the martyrs.

It is the natural duty of Party organizations, and an important responsibility they must never neglect, to organize and conduct diverse types of edifying work with the students of the revolutionary schools when they visit their homes during vacations, as well as to attach importance to the schools' graduates and take care of their work and family circumstances, along with their political life, while making detailed inquiries about them.

They should prize the graduates of Mangyongdae Revolutionary School and Kang Pan Sok Revolutionary School, whom the Party has devoted so much effort to training, properly conduct the work of appointing them as cadres, and educate and help them to fulfil their duties.

They should keep up-to-date with the circumstances of all the bereaved families whose children are attending the revolutionary schools, make regular inquiries about them, and find positive and prompt solutions to the

problems which arise in their work and life so as to lead them to be loyal to the Party and the revolution without the slightest idle thought or deviation and to have a positive influence on their own children.

Comrade graduates of the revolutionary schools present here,

While working in different regions and sectors as hardcore forces of our revolutionary and class positions, you should make more strenuous efforts, always conscious of the Party's trust and the people's expectations.
